Punishing parents who cannot convince their children to attend irrelevant school classes does not help anyone. Bring back bilingual education. The Bush Mob children begin school speaking only their mother tongue. How can they be expected to learn in a language that is totally foreign to them. You might as well have all Australian school children have their first 4 hours of schooling in German! It is no different.

The situation in the Northern Territory is heart breaking. The manner in which the First Australians live is heart breaking. The way they are treated is heart breaking.
