We are concerned residents of Sandy Point and are very worried about the failing health of our Koala population. We desperately need the Sandy Point Koalas listed as vulnerable and endangered. We now struggle to find them.

We have recently found several dead Koalas and have since also sent sick Koalas to Colleen Wood at southern Ash Wildlife Shelter in Rawson Victoria. Colleen has rehabilitated a young female called "MISSY" who is now supporting a red tab in her ear. She has been successfully released at Sandy Point and is doing well.

We need help and funding through Southern Ash to find out what is causing illness and death in our Koala population.

We believe funding and support is greatly needed in the research area to enable veterinary assistance, blood analyses and genetic testing to confirm why our Koalas are sick and dying.

Please help save Sandy Point Gippsland's Koala Population.
